The Unity Council is elected to oversee the administration of the FU Process (including approving topics for Community Assemblies) and to participate in a collective process of Voice and Recommend designed to inform the community of opportunities for our collective rise, obstacles to our collective rise, and issues that need our attention. The Unity Council uses their collective knowledge and experiences, and special interest advisories such as the Youth Advisory and the Pan-African Advisory to develop ideas for V&R's.

New members are elected to The Unity Council each year in teams of 4 to serve 3 years. Once an elected member has successfully completed his/her term, he/she is honored at an Appreciation Banquet and then moves on to different types of leadership throughout the System of Functional Unity.
